

WHAT IS PROBUS?

A **PROBUS** Club is a local association of retired and semi-retired **PRO**fessional and **BUS**iness people. Clubs meet regularly for fellowship and an extension of their interests. Each club is autonomous and chooses its own rules and programme.

WHO ARE PROBUS MEMBERS?

PROBUS members are retired or semi-retired professional and business people having a background and experience compatible with their colleagues. There are no upper or lower age limits. Clubs may be mixed gender, men only or women only.

WHAT DOES PROBUS DO?

PROBUS exists to provide a social forum, fellowship and friendship for like-minded people.

PROBUS is NOT a fundraising organisation.

PROBUS is not affiliated to a central organising body with each PROBUS Club setting its own rules.

PROBUS Clubs organise functions, sporting and social events, outings and even holidays for members, partners and guests.

ASHDOWN PROBUS CLUB

Ashdown Probus Club is a social club formed to promote fellowship and friendship amongst its members. Centred on Crowborough, our general catchment area extends northwards towards East Grinstead and Tunbridge Wells, southwards towards Uckfield and Mayfield, and eastwards and westwards towards Wadhurst and Danehill / Chelwood Gate respectively.

Ashdown Probus Club elects its own officers - a president, vice-president, secretary, treasurer and committee members covering membership, lunch and speaker selection.

Ashdown Probus Club does not exist to raise money for charity, although the club may run occasional fund-raising events and raffles.



Monthly luncheons Meeting at Crowborough Beacon Golf Club, Beacon Road, Crowborough, TN6 1UJ, the monthly luncheon is held on the second Monday of each month. Members gather at 12.00 noon for a 12.30 p.m. two course meal and coffee followed by a guest speaker and questions.

Functions With the exception of monthly luncheons, members' wives and partners are invited to participate in all other social activities. Functions include the Christmas Lunch, the President's Lunch and a Summer Picnic.

Ashdown Probus Club activities include Croquet in Tunbridge Wells on the second Tuesday of each month (May to September) and a choice of joining any of three countryside walking groups for regular five mile monthly walks throughout the year, all ending with an optional celebratory pub lunch.



Outings Outings to varied and fascinating places are enjoyed in the company of wives, partners and friends throughout the year. Trips to London and theatre outings are popular. Outings can be by train, coach or members' own transport.
